## Action Item Agenda Item 2a Applicant #559 Licensure Committee Proposed Non-Public Non-Disciplinary Rehabilitation Order August 23, 2007

Applicant #559s application was reviewed due to the applicants mental condition that may affect the practice of medicine, namely, Major Depressive Disorder.

Dr. Guajardo moved to recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted a Physician in Training permit under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order for the duration of the Physician in Training Permit that includes the following requirements:

- Submit up to 3 names for treating psychiatrist for approval of ED; frequency of visits will be based on recommendation by treating psychiatrist. Treating psychiatrist to report to Board or monitoring psychiatrist 4 times each year.
- Treating psychiatrist may agree to be monitoring psychiatrist or ED appoints a monitoring psychiatrist; monitoring psychiatrist to report to Board 2 times each year.
- o Reports by Applicant/Respondent regarding physical or mental condition on request
- O Shall not withdraw from care, or treatment
- o Notify Compliance upon discontinuation of care/treatment
- Respondent must give copy of Order to Program Director and request quarterly reports
- May supervise PAs and APNs
- o Anytime on request & 10 days notice
