## Action Item Agenda Item 2a2 Applicant #837 Licensure Committee Proposed Public Non-Disciplinary Order August 20, 2009

Applicant #837 appeared with counsel, before the Committee, in executive session, on appeal of an order offered by the Executive Director. In open session, Mr. Turner moved to recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted a Physician in Training permit under the public, non-disciplinary order that was previously proposed by the Executive Director. This recommendation is due to unprofessional or dishonorable conduct likely to deceive, defraud or injure the public; intemperate use of alcohol that could endanger a patients life; and violation of a state law that involved as sault as an essential element. Factors contributing to this recommendation include a criminal his tory involving multiple arrests and convictions for alcohol-related charges, resisting arrest, and assault; no criminal actions since 2001; evidence of sobriety and completion of alcohol abuse treatment; and that applicants residency program is aware of applicants criminal and alcohol issues and plans to monitor.

Ms. Southard seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.
