Licensure Committee Proposed Non-Public Non-Disciplinary Rehabilitation Order
November 29, 2007

Applicant #499s appeared before the Committee to appeal the length of the transition order offered to continue monitoring after completion of residency program. Order was offered due to alcohol dependence and major depression, recurrent

Mr. Turner moved to recommend to the full board that the applicant be granted a Texas medical license under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order for ten years that includes the following requirements:

- Abstain from alcohol and drugs, except as prescribed; comply with TMB screening program; automatic suspension of license for positive test.
- Submit to an Independent Psychiatric Evaluation by a psychiatrist appointed by the Executive Director and follow recommendations. If continued care is recommended, applicant will submit up to three names as treating psychiatrist for approval by Executive Director. Treating psychiatrist to report Board or monitoring psychiatrist four times each year.
- Treating psychiatrist may agree to be monitoring psychiatrist or the Executive Director will appoint a monitoring psychiatrist; monitoring psychiatrist to report to the Board two times each year.
- Reports by Applicant/Respondent regarding physical or mental condition on request.
- Shall not withdraw from care, or treatment.
- Notify Compliance upon discontinuation of care/treatment.
- May supervise PAs and APNs.
- Probation appearance at least once the first year and then on request.
