TEXAS MEDICAL BOARD LICENSURE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES October 19, 2017

The meeting was called to order 9:33 a.m. by Chair, Timothy Webb. Committee members present were Michael Cokinos, Frank S. Denton, Kandace Farmer, D.O., and Paulette Southard.

Mr. Cokinos moved, Ms. Southard seconded that the Committee close the meeting to the public and continue in Executive Session for deliberations concerning Agenda Items 2a. The motion passed. Mr. Webb announced that the meeting would be closed for deliberations at 9:37 a.m. concerning licensure applications and the character and fitness of applicants under the authority of The Medical Practice Act Sections 152.009 and 155.058, Occupations Code, and that while in executive session, the Board would not take any action, make any decision, or vote with regard to any matter that may be considered or discussed. A certified agenda of any executive session will be made.

The Executive Session ended at 11:56 a.m. The Licensure Committee conducted hearings to review applicants appearing concerning eligibility. The hearings were conducted in Executive Session. Following the hearings, the Committee reconvened and considered the applications.

Agenda Item 2a - Applicants appearing concerning eligibility.

Applicant #2081 appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in executive session. In open session, Mr. Denton moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the Applicant's appeal of the determination of ineligibility for licensure due to failure to demonstrate compliance with applicable statutory requirements be deferred pending the results of the Applicant's specialty board certification examination, and upon receiving results showing passage, staff issue a full and unrestricted license. This recommendation is based on the Applicant's ability to resolve the basis of his ineligibility for licensure. Mr. Cokinos seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.

Applicant #2084 appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in executive session. In open session, **Dr. Farmer moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the Applicant's appeal of the Executive's Director offer of an Agreed Order be granted and the Applicant be granted an unrestricted license. Mr. Denton seconded the motion. The motion passed.**

Applicant #2108 appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in executive session. In open session, **Mr. Cokinos moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted an unrestricted license. Dr. Farmer seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Applicant #1545 appeared before the Committee, with counsel, in executive session. In open session **Ms. Southard moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant be determined ineligible for a license.** This recommendation is based on the Applicant's history of unprofessional conduct, failure to practice medicine within the standard of care, being disciplined by another state board, and disciplinary action taken by a health care entity. **Mr. Denton seconded the motion.** All voted in favor. The motion passed.

Agenda Item 2b – Proposed orders offered by the Executive Director.

Ms. Johnston reported on **6 Remedial Plans** order offered by the Executive Director and accepted by the applicants. **Ms. Southard moved to recommend to the full Board that the 6 Remedial Plans be approved. Dr. Farmer seconded. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Agenda Item 2c – Physician licensure applicants to be licensed.

Ms. Johnston reported that there were **132** applicants who met all requirements to be considered for permanent licensure by the full Board. **Ms. Southard moved to recommend to the full Board that all 132 physician licensure applicants determined to meet eligibility requirements by staff be approved**. **Dr. Farmer seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed**.

Agenda Item 2d – Surgical assistant licensure applicants to be licensed.

Ms. Johnston reported that were **8** surgical assistant applicants who met all requirements to be considered for licensure by the full Board. Ms. Southard moved to recommend to the full Board that all **8** surgical assistant applicants determined to meet eligibility requirements by staff be approved. Mr. Denton seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.

Agenda Item 2e – Acudetox Specialist applicants to be certified.

There are none.

Agenda Item 3 – Report on licensure statistics.

Ms. Johnston reported that in Quarter 1 of FY17, 917 new physician licenses were issued in an average processing time of 42 days. In Quarter 1 of FY 18, 573 license have been issued in an aver processing time of 46 days.

Ms. Johnson further reported that in FY16, 4093 new physician licenses were issued in an average processing time of 40 days. But in all of FY17, 4719 new licenses were issued in an average processing time of 41 days which is a record number of physician licenses issued.

Agenda Item 4a -Nonprofit Health Organizations - Applications for Initial Certification.

Ms. Johnston reported that were 8 applications for initial certification as a Nonprofit Health Organization for approval. Mr. Cokinos moved to recommend to the full Board that the 8 requests for initial certification as a Nonprofit Health Organization be approved. Ms. Southard seconded. All voted in favor and the motion passed.

Agenda Item 4b - Nonprofit Health Organizations - Applications for Biennial Recertification.

There are none.

Agenda Item 4c - Nonprofit Health Organizations – Cancellation of Certification. Ms. Johnston reported that were 2 requests for cancellation of certification as a Nonprofit Health Organization. Mr. Cokinos moved to recommend to the full Board that the 2 requests for

cancellation of certification as a Nonprofit Health Organization be approved. Ms. Southard seconded. All voted in favor and the motion passed.

RULE §194.34PurposeThe purpose of these rules is
to implement the provisions
of the Medical Radiologic
Technologist Certification
Act, Texas Occupations
Code Chapter 601 ("the
Act") applicable to non-
certified radiologic
technicians or non-certified
technicians.Purpose

RULE §194.35

Definitions

The following words and terms, when used in this chapter, shall have the following meanings, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

-(1) Board--The Texas Medical Board.

-(2) Non-certified technician (NCT) or registrant--A person who is registered with the board and either:

— (A) is listed on the current general registry with the Texas Board of Medical Radiologic Technology under §194.6 of this chapter (relating to Procedural Rules and Minimum Eligibility Requirements for Applicants for a Certificate or Placement on the Board's Non-Certified Technician General Registry); or

(B) performs radiologic procedures for a physician to whom a hardship exemption was granted by the Texas Board of Medical Radiologic Technology within the previous year under §194.16 of this chapter (relating to Hardship Exemptions).

-(3) Supervision--Responsibility for and control of quality, radiation safety and protection, and technical aspects of the application of ionizing radiation to human beings for diagnostic purposes.

RULE §194.36 Registration

(a) Any person in the State of Texas performing radiologic procedures, as defined in §194.38 of this chapter (relating to Non-Certified Technician's Scope of Practice), under the supervision of a current and active licensed Texas physician, must be registered with the Texas Medical Board. The physician must also be registered with the board to supervise the non-certified technician.
 (b) This section does not apply to registered nurses or to persons certified by the Texas Board of Medical Radiologic Technology under the Medical Radiologic Technologist Certification Act.
 (c) An applicant shall apply for registration with the board on a form provided by the board and

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shall pay the appropriate fee established by the board. Each physician, who supervises a noncertified technician, shall apply on a separate application form.

(d) Applicants shall be 18 years of age or older and either:

-(1) provide proof of the applicant's registry as an NCT with the Texas Board of Medical Radiologic Technology under §194.6 of this chapter (relating to Procedural Rules and Minimum Eligibility Requirements for Applicants for a Certificate or Placement on the Board's Non-Certified Technician General Registry); or

(2) perform radiologic procedures for a physician to whom a hardship exemption was granted by the Texas Board of Medical Radiologic Technology within the previous year under §194.16 of this chapter(relating to Hardship Exemptions). A person who operates a bone densitometry unit(s) which utilizes x-radiation who is in compliance with §194.15 of this chapter (relating to Bone Densitometry Training), however, is not required to obtain a hardship exemption as long as the person is not performing radiologic procedures other than bone densitometry.

RULE §194.37 Annual Renewal

(a) Registrants shall renew the registration annually by:

-(1) submitting a completed registration application;

-(2) paying a fee, as specified by the board under Chapter 175 of this title (relating to Fees and Penalties); and

-(3) providing proof of the registrant's renewal of status on the Texas Board of Medical Radiologic Technology registry or that the registrant is working under a physician hardship exemption, if applicable.

(b) If the registrant fails to comply with subsection (a) of this section on or before the expiration date of the registration, the following penalties as shown in paragraphs (1) and (2) of this subsection will be imposed:

(1) one to 90 days late--penalty fee set under §175.3(4) of this title (relating to Penalties);
(2) over 90 days late the registrant may not renew his or her registration, and the registration will be considered expired, unless an investigation is pending. The registrant must submit a new application and comply with the requirements and procedures for obtaining a permit.
(c) The board by rule may adopt a system under which registrations expire on various dates during the year. For the year in which the expiration date is changed, registration fees payable on or before January 1 shall be prorated on a monthly basis so that each registrant shall pay only that portion of the registration fee which is allocable to the number of months during which the registration is valid. On renewal of the registration on the new expiration date, the total registration is payable.

(d) Registrants shall inform the board in writing of address changes within two weeks.

RULE §194.38 Non-Certified Technician's Scope of Practice

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(a) A registrant may only perform the following radiologic procedures, as listed in paragraphs (1) and (2) of this subsection unless otherwise expressly permitted by statute or rule:

-(1) bone densitometry utilizing a dual energy x-ray densitometer; or

-(2) chest, spine, extremities, abdomen, skull studies or other radiologic procedures utilizing standard film or film screen combinations and an x-ray tube that is stationary at the time of exposure; however, a registrant may not perform a procedure which has been identified as dangerous or hazardous by the Texas Board of Medical Radiologic Technology in §194.17 of this chapter (relating to Dangerous or Hazardous Procedures).

(b) A registrant, other than a physician assistant, shall perform all radiologic procedures under the direct supervision or instruction of a physician in the State of Texas.

(c) A supervising physician may not order, instruct, or direct a registrant to perform a radiologic procedure other than in compliance with applicable statutes and rules.

(d) All registrants must comply with the safety rules of the Texas Department of State Health Services relating to the control of radiation as set forth in 25 TAC Chapter 289 (relating to Radiation Control).

RULE §194.39 Suspension, Revocation or Nonrenewal of Registration

(a) The board may refuse to issue a registration to an applicant and may, following notice of hearing and a hearing as provided for in the Administrative Procedure Act, take disciplinary action against any non-certified technician who:

-(1) violates the Medical Practice Act, the rules of the Texas Medical Board, an order of the board previously entered in a disciplinary proceeding, or an order to comply with a subpoena issued by the board;

-(2) violates the Medical Radiologic Technologist Certification Act or the rules promulgated by the Texas Board of Medical Radiologic Technology;

-(3) violates the rules of the Texas Department of State Health Services for control of radiation; -(4) obtains, attempts to obtain, or uses a registration by bribery or fraud;

-(5) engages in unprofessional conduct, including, but not limited to, conviction of a crime, commission of any act that is in violation of the laws of the State of Texas if the act is connected with provision of health care, and commission of an act of moral turpitude;

-(6) develops or has an incapacity that prevents the practice of radiologic technology with reasonable skill, competence, and safety to the public as a result of:

(A) an illness;

- (B) drug or alcohol dependency; or habitual use of drugs or intoxicating liquors; or

-(C) another physical or mental condition;

-(7) fails to practice as a non-certified technician in an acceptable manner consistent with public health and welfare;

-(8) has disciplinary action taken against a certification, permit, or registration in another state, territory, or country or by another regulatory agency;

-(9) engages in acts requiring registration under these rules without a current registration from

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the board; or

-(10) is removed, suspended, or has had disciplinary action taken against the registrant. (b) The board may suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew the registration of a non-certified technician, upon a finding that a non-certified technician has committed any offense listed in this section.

RULE §194.40 Disciplinary Guidelines

(a) Chapter 190 of this title (relating to Disciplinary Guidelines) shall apply to certificate holders, registrants, and permit holders regulated under this chapter to be used as guidelines for the following areas as they relate to the denial of registration or disciplinary action taken against a registrant:

-(1) practice inconsistent with public health and welfare;

-(2) unprofessional and dishonorable conduct; and

-(3) aggravating and mitigating factors.

(b) If the provisions of Chapter 190 of this title conflict with the rules under this chapter or the Medical Radiological Technologist Act, the provisions of this chapter and the Act shall control.

RULE §194.41 Procedure

Chapter 187 of this title (relating to Procedural Rules) shall govern procedures relating to registrants where applicable. If the provisions of Chapter 187 of this title conflict with the Act or rules under this chapter, the Act and provisions of this chapter shall control.

RULE §194.42 Compliance

Chapter 189 of this title (relating to Compliance Program) shall be applied to registrants who are under board orders. If the provisions of Chapter 189 of this title conflict with the Act or rules under this chapter, the Act and provisions of this chapter shall control.

RULE §194.43 Construction

The provisions of this chapter shall be construed and interpreted so as to be consistent with the statutory provisions of the Medical Practice Act. In the event of a conflict between this chapter and the provisions of the Medical Practice Act, the provisions of the Medical Practice Act shall control; however, this chapter shall be construed so that all other provisions of this chapter which are not in conflict with the Act shall remain in effect.

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SUBCHAPTER F. OTHER LICENSING AGENCIES; RULEMAKING AND REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

Sec. 601.251. APPLICABILITY. This subchapter applies to the:

- (1) Texas Board of Nursing;
- (2) Texas Board of Chiropractic Examiners;
- (3) State Board of Dental Examiners;
- (4) Texas Medical Board;
- (5) Texas State Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners;

and

(6) Texas Physician Assistant Board.

Sec. 601.252. REQUIREMENT TO ADOPT RULES. (a) Each agency subject to this subchapter, other than the Texas Board of Nursing and the Texas Physician Assistant Board, shall adopt rules to regulate the manner in which a person who holds a license issued by the agency may order, instruct, or direct another authorized person in the performance of a radiologic procedure.

(b) Rules adopted under Subsection (a) must allow a practitioner the right to delegate certain designated radiologic procedures to a person not certified under this chapter if the delegation is allowed by the regulatory board that licenses the practitioner.

(c) Rules adopted under this section by the State Board of Dental Examiners must:

(1) require an authorized person <u>who performs</u> <u>radiologic procedures under the delegation of a dentist</u>, other than a registered nurse, to register with the <u>dental board</u> [agency that licenses the practitioner under whom the person performs radiologic procedures];

(2) establish reasonable and necessary fees to cover the administrative costs incurred by the <u>dental board</u> [agency] in administering a registration program created under this subsection; (3) establish grounds for the suspension, revocation, or nonrenewal of a registration issued under this subsection; and

(4) establish standards, in addition to those required by this chapter, for training and supervising the operators of the equipment.

(d) In adopting rules under Subsection (c), <u>the State</u> <u>Board of Dental Examiners [an agency]</u>may take into account whether the radiologic procedure will be performed by a registered nurse.
