## TEXAS PHYSICIANS ASSISTANT BOARD MINUTES OF THE DISCIPLINE AND ETHICS COMMITTEE December 14, 2012

Chair Anna Arredondo Chapman, called the meeting to order at 10:04 a.m. Other members present were Margaret K. Bentley, Linda Contreras, P.A., and Felix Koo, M.D. Committee Member Reginald C. Baptiste, M.D., was not present.

Established circa February 2010, Executive Director of the Texas Physician Health Program (TX PHP), Dr. Bill Nemeth, was introduced to the Texas Physicians Assistant Board Discipline and Ethics Committee.
