## Action Item Agenda Item 2a Applicant #647 Licensure Committee Proposed Non-Public Non-Disciplinary Rehabilitation Order April 10, 2008

Applicant #647s application was reviewed due to a mental condition that may affect the practice of medicine.

Ms. Southard moved to recommend to the full board that the applicant be granted a Texas medical license under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order for 10 years that includes the following requirements:

- Submit up to three names for treating psychiatrist for approval by Executive Director; see at least once every two months. In addition applicant is to continue to see their current psychologist every other week. Treating psychiatrist to report to Board or monitoring psychiatrist four times each year.
- Treating psychiatrist may agree to be monitoring psychiatrist or the Executive Director will
  appoint a monitoring psychiatrist; monitoring psychiatrist to report to the Board two times
  each year.
- o Reports by Applicant/Respondent regarding physical or mental condition on request.
- o Shall not withdraw from care, or treatment.
- o Notify Compliance upon discontinuation of care/treatment.
- Restriction to approved group setting.
- May supervise PAs and APNs.
- Probation appearance at least once the first year and then on request.
