After considering the applicants Physician in Training permit application including the applicants arrest for possession of marijuana, training probation and subsequent termination from training program, and history of substance abuse, the Executive Director recommends that the applicant be granted a Physician in Training permit under the terms and conditions listed below. The applicant has agreed to and signed this proposed order. Mr. Turner moved to recommend to the full Board that the order be approved. Dr. Benavides seconded. All voted in favor and the motion passed.

Order allows applicant to be granted a Physician in Training permit under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order for the duration of the Physician in Training Permit that includes the following requirements:

- Abstain from alcohol and drugs, except as prescribed; comply with TMB screening program; automatic suspension of permit for positive test.
- o Attend AA meetings at least three times each week
- Submit up to three names for treating psychiatrist for approval by Executive Director;
 see at least once every three months and follow all recommendations. Treating
 psychiatrist to report to Board or monitoring psychiatrist four times each year.
- Treating psychiatrist may agree to be monitoring psychiatrist or the Executive
 Director will appoint a monitoring psychiatrist; monitoring psychiatrist to report to
 the Board two times each year.
- o Reports by Applicant/Respondent regarding physical or mental condition on request.
- o Shall not withdraw from care, or treatment.
- Notify Compliance upon discontinuation of care/treatment.
- o Must give copy of Order to Program Director and request quarterly reports
- May supervise PAs and APNs.
- o Probation appearance at least once the first year and then on request.
