Applicant #586s application was reviewed due to alcohol dependence, an arrest and training probation.

Mr. Turner recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted a Texas medical license under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order for ten years that includes the following requirements:

- Abstain from alcohol and drugs except as prescribed; comply with TMB screening program; automatic suspension of license for positive test.
- Submit up to three names for treating psychiatrist for approval by Executive Director; see at least once every three months. Treating psychiatrist to report to Board or monitoring psychiatrist four times each year. Include referral to AA by treating psychiatrist as needed.
- Treating psychiatrist may agree to be monitoring psychiatrist or the Executive Director will appoint a monitoring psychiatrist; monitoring psychiatrist to report to the Board two times each year.
- o Reports by Applicant/Respondent regarding physical or mental condition on request.
- Shall not withdraw from care, or treatment.
- o Notify Compliance upon discontinuation of care/treatment.
- o May supervise PAs and APNs.
- Probation appearance at least once the first year and then on request.
