Licensure Committee Proposed **Non-Public** Non-Disciplinary Rehabilitation Order
December 7, 2006

Applicant #503s application was reviewed due to mental impairment and failure to have in the active practice of medicine within the last two years.

Dr. Arambula moved that the Committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant be determined ineligible for licensure due to mental impairment based on a diagnosis of schizophrenia, paranoid type and failure to have been in the active practice of medicine within the last two years.

Upon receipt of a request for a physician in training permit for a fellowship program in Family Medicine, of no less than one year, that the physician in training permit be granted by the Executive Director under a non-public, non-disciplinary rehabilitation order that includes the following requirements.

- Continue treatment with Helen G Albanese, MD; see at least weekly with quarterly reports.
- Submit three names for monitoring psychiatrist for approval of ED with quarterly reports.
- Must furnish reports regarding physical or mental condition on request.
- Shall not unilaterally withdraw from evaluation, care or treatment.
- Notify Compliance upon discontinuation of care or treatment.
- Probation appearance anytime on request and 10 days notice.
- Quarterly reports from Fellowship Program Director.
- The applicant must appear before the Licensure Committee before being granted a full physician license in the future.
