DISCIPLINARY PROCESS REVIEW COMMITTEE

Agenda Item #2. Texas Physician Health Program (TXPHP).

A. Discussion, Recommendation, and Possible Action Regarding Referrals

Mr. Gracia moved and Ms. Barnes seconded that TXPHP Case No. 17-0256-A MD, 17-0281 MD, 18-0168-A PIT MD, 19-0397-A MD, 20-0417 PIT MD, 21-0308 MD, 21-0716 MD, 21-0810 MD, 22-0104 MD, 22-0804 MD, remain under the management of TXPHP. Motion carried.
