2. Passage of PANCEWithin 6 attempts
3. Current NCCPA Certification
4. Texas Medical Jurisprudence Examination Score of 75 or better, unlimited attempts
Demonstration of Competence
5. Current Clinical Practice as a Physician Assistant Demonstrates clinical practice as a physician assistant within the last 3 years preceding the date of Application by currently practicing as a physician assistant involving treatment of persons, enrollment as a student in an acceptable approved physician assistant program, or appointment as an active teaching faculty member in an acceptable approved physician assistant program.
Other Eligibility Requirements
6. Disciplinary History Has not been issued a license, certificate, or registration as a physician assistant in this state or from a licensing authority in another state that is revoked or suspended; or Is not subject to probation or other disciplinary action for cause resulting from the applicant's acts as a physician assistant.
7. Criminal History ——Has no pending prosecution in any state, federal, or Canadian court for any offense that under the laws of this state is a felony or a misdemeanor that involves moral turpitude.
